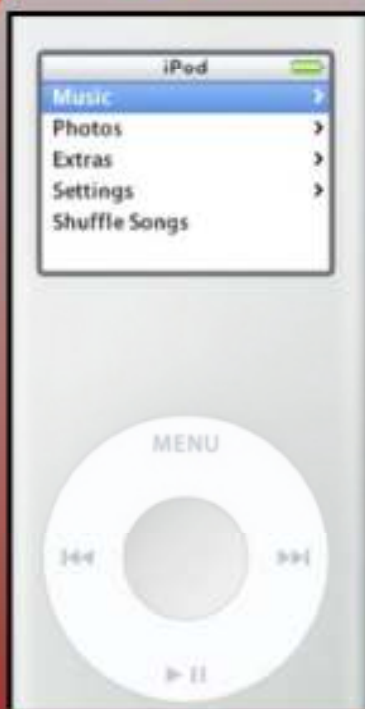

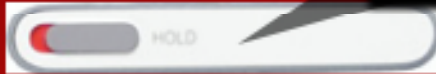

# BUTTONS

## Hold

*SLIDE TO DISABLE THE CLICK WHEEL.*

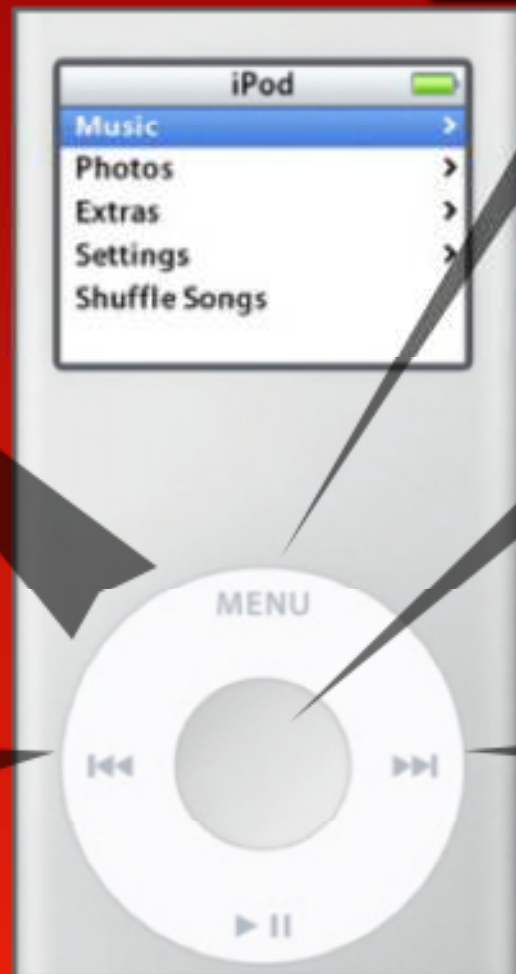


## Menu

*THE MENU BUTTON FUNCTIONS LIKE A BACK BUTTON, GOING TO THE LAST SCREEN*

## Click Wheel

*TO SCROLL UP AND DOWN RUB YOUR THUMB AROUND THE CLICK WHEEL*



## Center Button

*SELECTS THE ITEM THAT IS HIGHLIGHTED.*

## Previous

*THE REWIND BUTTON WILL START THE AUDIO OVER, OR GO TO THE PREVIOUS TRACK.*

## Next

*PRESS TO GO TO THE NEXT TRACK OR HOLD DOWN TO FAST FORWARD.*

## Play/ Pause

*THE PLAY BUTTON TURNS THE IPOD ON AND HELD DOWN FOR THREE SECONDS TURNS IT OFF.*

## Connector Port



*SYNC WITH ITUNES AND THE HEADPHONE OR SPEAKER PORT.*

# iTunes



**THE IPOD NANO WILL ONLY WORK WITH THE ITUNES PROGRAM. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE IT, GO TO [WWW.APPLE.COM/ITUNES/DOWNLOAD](http://WWW.APPLE.COM/ITUNES/DOWNLOAD)**

This is the playlist panel. To create a playlist, click the + button, then drag music or podcasts into the playlist.



The iTunes Store is one way to find music, audio books and podcasts.

These buttons are Shuffle, Repeat and Eject CD.

To rename a playlist, double click on it.

This is the Mini player. It can float over other windows. To open it on a PC go to advanced, select Switch to Mini Player. On a Mac click the green maximize button in iTunes.

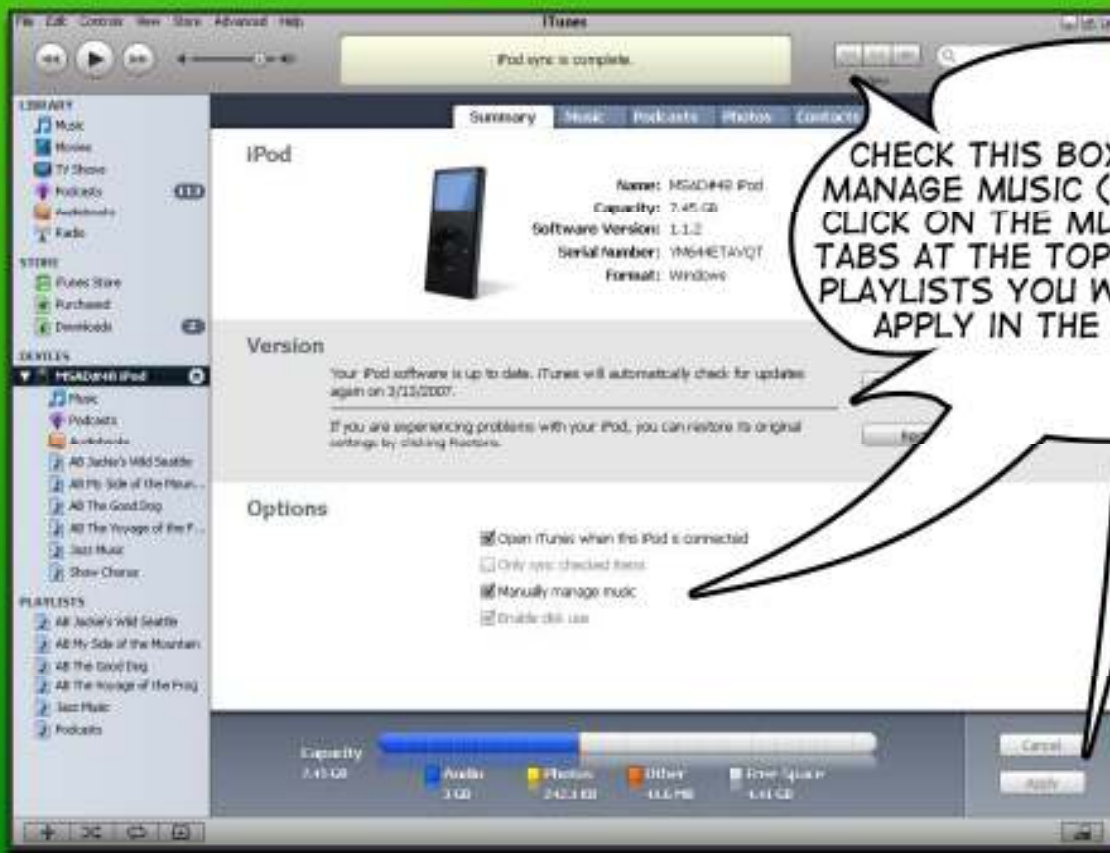
# Syncing the iPod



PLUG THE IPOD INTO ANY USB PORT IN THE COMPUTER.



ITUNES WILL OPEN AND THIS PANEL WILL APPEAR ON THE LEFT SIDE.



CHECK THIS BOX TO MANUALLY MANAGE MUSIC (AND PODCASTS.) CLICK ON THE MUSIC OR PODCAST TABS AT THE TOP AND SELECT THE PLAYLISTS YOU WANT, THEN CLICK APPLY IN THE LOWER RIGHT.

**Note:** Do not disconnect the iPod while files are being synced. A message will be displayed when the iPod sync is completed. Click the eject symbol next to the iPod icon on the left which will disengage the iPod safely.

# Podcasts

A PODCAST IS AN AUDIO FILE RECORDED AND DISTRIBUTED OVER THE INTERNET. ITUNES IS A POPULAR WAY TO ACCESS PODCASTS AND UPDATE THEM ONTO THE IPOD. ANOTHER RESOURCE FOR EDUCATIONAL PODCASTS IS EPNWEB.ORG HERE ARE THE THREE STEPS TO LISTENING TO A PODCAST.

## Step 1

OPEN THE ITUNES MUSIC STORE AND CLICK ON THE PODCASTS LINK.



## Step 2

CLICK ON THE IMAGE OF THE PODCAST YOU WANT. A BRIEF SUMMARY AND LIST OF EPISODES WILL APPEAR. AS NEW EPISODES ARE AVAILABLE, THEY ARE AUTOMATICALLY DOWNLOADED TO ITUNES.

## Step 3

CLICK ON THE SUBSCRIBE BUTTON NEXT TO THE IMAGE OF THE PODCAST. TO DOWNLOAD AN OLDER EPISODE, CLICK THE GET BUTTON NEXT TO THE EPISODE. THESE WILL BE SENT TO THE IPOD THE NEXT TIME IT IS SYNCED.

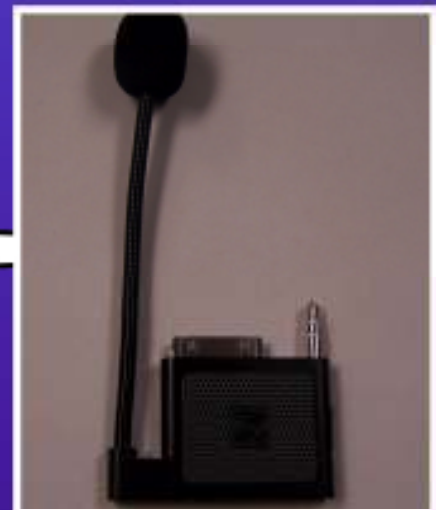
# Peripherals

THIS CORD ALLOWS YOU TO SYNC AND CHARGE YOUR IPOD. IT NORMALLY TAKES THREE HOURS FOR A FULL CHARGE. THE CHARGE LASTS ABOUT 24 HOURS.



THE ITRIP CAN PLUG INTO THE IPOD AND BROADCASTS TO AN FM CHANNEL. (USUALLY 87.9) THIS PLAYS ON MOST RADIOS. IT CAN ALSO BE USED AS A CHARGER WITH A STANDARD USB CABLE.

THE MICROMEMO IS A MICROPHONE USED TO RECORD AND SAVE AUDIO. THIS CAN THEN BE DOWNLOADED ON THE COMPUTER TO CREATE A PODCAST.



THE AV CONNECTION KIT WILL PLUG AN IPOD INTO A PROJECTOR OR TV. THIS WILL DISPLAY PHOTOS STORED ON THE IPOD LIKE A SLIDE SHOW.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## ***How do I turn the iPod on and off?***

To turn the iPod on, press anywhere on the click wheel. To turn the iPod off, hold down the play button for 3 seconds.

## ***Will it work will my Mac or PC?***

Yes, the iPod will work on a Mac or PC, but it can only be formatted for one or the other.

## ***How do I set the iPod to sync manually?***

iTunes will come up when you plug in the iPod to the computer. At the bottom of the screen, make sure it is set to manual.

## ***How do I change the volume?***

Move your thumb around the Click Wheel.

## ***How do I make a playlist?***

Playlists can only be made in iTunes by clicking the + button found in the lower left.

## ***The iPod is frozen, now what do I do?***

To reset the iPod, slide the Hold button on and off, then press the Menu and Center button down at the same time for 6 seconds to reset it.
